- ❖ 1 (1 inch) three ring binder for Math and 3 pocket dividers put inside
- ❖ 1 (1 inch) three ring binder for English and 3 pocket dividers put inside
- ❖ 1 (1 inch) three ring binder for Reading and Spelling and 3 pocket dividers put inside
- ❖ 1 (1 inch) three ring binder for Social Studies/Science and 3 pocket dividers put inside
- ❖ WE WILL USE THE FOUR NOTEBOOKS LISTED ABOVE INSTEAD OF SPIRAL BOUND STYLE
- ❖ 10 pack of sheet protectors (we will organize the notebooks when school begins)
- ❖ 1 hardcover journal composition notebook for daily journaling (these are usually black and white marble color)
- ❖ Notebook paper, **WIDE-RULED** (2 packages of 200 sheets minimum)
- ❖ Sturdy 3 ring binder (OUR STAR BINDER) (1 ½" in size PLEASE) with a CLEAR pocket on BOTH front and back in which a piece of paper can be inserted (* NO BIGGER THAN 1 1/2" PLEASE)
- ❖ A small sized dry erase board, dry erase marker and an eraser to do math problems on during class instruction.

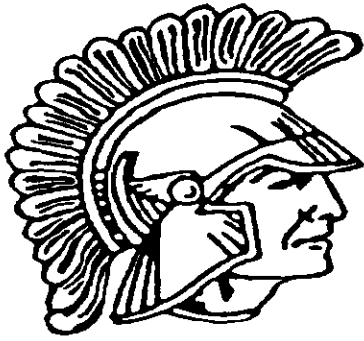

- 4 **Jumbo** book covers. It is not necessary, but it would help, if the book covers could coordinate with the binder color. For example blue binder/blue book cover, red binder/red book cover, etc.
